

DUTIES OF A MEMBER

An active NHW member is one who:

- Knows what to do when a crime or other emergencies occur
- Knows their neighbours and is willing to help them
- Observes the unusual and reports it
- Takes sensible precautions for their own home and personal security
- Reports crime/suspicious activity to the police
- Updates their co-ordinator of any changes to their contact details

USEFUL TELEPHONE NUMBERS AND WHEN TO USE THEM

DEPARTMENT	TELEPHONE NUMBER	WHEN TO USE IT
Emergency	'999'	For emergency situations and if offences are in progress – when IMMEDIATE police attention is required
Communication Centre	101	Usual telephone number to report incidents such as burglaries, attempt burglaries, theft of cycles etc. Either number gives you the general switchboard. You should encourage all members to report ALL such incidents – no matter how trivial they seem. Without incidents being reported, statistics cannot be compiled and problem areas cannot be identified
